



## Young Adult Membership

To support growth of the game of golf, as well as Camelot's interest in creating appropriate membership opportunities for all age groups, we offer a Young Adult membership to those aged 19-39 (age calculated annually as of January 1<sup>st</sup>). This membership bridges the gap between our Junior membership, and our full membership (Regular), recognizing that those in this age group are starting to build their careers and their families. While welcome to apply for Regular membership to enjoy the fullest of privileges we offer, this Young Adult offer provides a path to gradually pay more as you become older with increasing membership benefits, until such time as you are ready to become a Regular Member.

The Young Adult Membership is a highly privileged Associate Membership (non-equity/non-voting). Camelot's fee schedule has four (4) levels, with age groupings as follows: **19-25, 26-30, 31-34, and 35-39**. The Initiation Fees, Food & Beverage minimum and Capital Improvement fees start at significantly discounted rates and gradually rise as members progress through the levels. Meanwhile, initiation fee installments are being pre-paid, to apply against the initiation fee applicable no later than age 40. Plus once you become a Young Adult, you lock in the initiation fee at the time of joining so you will not be subject to future initiation fee price increases so long as you maintain continuous membership.

### Membership Privileges

- Exceptional access to one of Canada's top 100 golf courses (**SCOREGolf 2020**)
- Use of a majestic Clubhouse, with a three-level patio overlooking both the finishing holes of the golf course, and the Ottawa River.
- Unlimited use of an expansive practice facility.
- Locker and shoe cleaning service (beginning at Level III).
- Complimentary amenities including tees, pull carts, club storage and cleaning.
- Access to our reciprocal playing program at 10 private clubs in Canada.

### Initiation Fee Program

- The respective annual initiation fee installment is due with initial application and billed annually in February.
- The full initiation fee is not required until age 40, but once a Young Adult joins the initiation fee in place at that time is locked into place so long as they remain a member.
- Installments payable as a Young Adult, so long as membership is held continuously, will be applied against the full initiation fee at time of application as a Regular member.
- Initiation fees paid are non-refundable and non-transferable.

### Young Adult 2022 Fee Structure

- Levels based on age on January 1<sup>st</sup> of the golfing season
- Cap of 60 Young Adults on Levels I to III
- Dues are billed in 4 installments with final payment due by April 1<sup>st</sup>
- Annual Dues & Capital Improvement Fees billed as % of Premium Member fees set by Board
- Hole-in-One charges apply to all levels at the rate of \$2 per hole-in-one, billed monthly
- Golf Canada Card billing of \$39+HST in May
- Should a Young Adult aged member prefer Regular membership privileges, they may apply but they will be subject to the applicable dues and not these discounted rates.

\*Playing restrictions apply (for Levels I & II only): no play weekends/holidays before 12pm & restricted access to Men's league

#A Young Adult aged 19-30 may choose to upgrade to Level III to have no playing restrictions but will be subject to all fees and dues applicable to Level III

^A Young Adult aged 19-34 may choose to upgrade to Level IV to have better tee-time lottery weighting privilege (2<sup>nd</sup> priority vs 3<sup>rd</sup> priority) but will be subject to all of the fees and dues applicable to Level IV

### Initiation Fee Installments

- ⌘ Initiation Fee installments paid accrue against future Initiation Fee payable to become Regular member of Camelot Golf & Country Club (no later than age 40)
- ⌘ Initiation Fee installments paid are non-refundable and non-transferable
- ⌘ Installments for existing Level III & Level IV as of January 31<sup>st</sup>/21 are waived so long as they qualify for the former Loyalty Bonus Program and maintain continuous golf membership

### Young Adult Family Program (parent or grandparent is an active Premium or Weekday Member)

- ⌘ Initiation Fee installments do not apply until Level III (deferred for those at Levels I & II)
- ⌘ For Levels I & II, exempt from weekend/holiday playing restriction if invited to play **with** their parent or grandparent who is an active Premium or Weekday Member
- ⌘ Notwithstanding the cap of 60, a Young Adult may join subject to the terms and conditions above where their parent is a Premium or Weekday member on a one-time basis



## Junior & Pre-Junior Membership

In keeping with the inclusive tradition at Camelot, Junior Members are an important facet of the entire Club experience. It is our belief that lessons learned at Camelot go far beyond those on the course. Respect, honesty, confidence and determination are just some of the ideals that are instilled in Junior Members.

Our Junior Program is overseen by a staff of dedicated PGA of Canada Golf Professionals. Junior Members are afforded direct access to regular clinics, practice sessions and on course tutorials. It is often not long before our Junior Members are outperforming mom and dad! Since this classification is only for the children or grandchildren of existing members a preferred rate is available and no membership cap applies.

### Membership Privileges:

- Juniors are 11-18 years of age; pre-Juniors are 6-10 years of age.
- Free clinics & a “walk the line” program, at established times, where juniors can receive help with various parts of their game on the range from professional staff.
- Pre-Juniors MUST play or practice with their member parent or member grandparent
- Opportunity to compete as a member of the Junior Intersectional team
- Match play (season long) and junior club championships
- Access to Eastern Ontario's premiere golf course Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday before noon & after 6pm; Wednesdays before 10am, Saturday, Sunday and Holidays after 1:00 PM
- Limited ability to fill in vacant spots in the afternoon where approved by the Pro Shop within 24 hours
- Complimentary use of the clubhouse, practice facility & amenities including pull carts
- Junior Membership does not include a locker or club storage
- Discounted registration for Junior Camps
- High performance juniors have the opportunity to apply for bursaries from our Junior Development Fund to support their competitive golf efforts.

### Membership Fees:

- **Junior \$500+HST or pre-Junior \$275+HST**
- **Golf Canada Card:** \$39+HST billed in May
- There is no minimum F&B requirement, Capital Improvement or hole-in-one fees payable
- **Complimentary membership for Juniors/pre-Junior of the Parent and/or Grandparent of Premium/Weekday/Spousal or Senior members (one per adult member)**



## Sponsored Junior Membership

In keeping with the inclusive tradition at Camelot, Junior Members are an important facet of the entire Club experience. It is our belief that lessons learned at Camelot go far beyond those on the course. Respect, honesty, confidence and determination are just some of the ideals that are instilled in Junior Members.

Our Junior Program is overseen by a staff of dedicated PGA Golf Professionals. Junior Members are afforded direct access to regular clinics, practice sessions and on course tutorials. It is often not long before our Junior Members are outperforming mom and dad!

## Membership Privileges:

- For Juniors that are between 11-18 years of age
- Must be sponsored by an adult Camelot golfing member
- A membership cap applies as set annually by the Board of Governors
- Free clinics & a “walk the line” program, at established times, where juniors can receive help with various parts of their game on the range from professional staff.
- Opportunity to compete as a member of the Junior intersectional team
- Match play (season long) and junior club championships
- Access to Eastern Ontario's premiere golf course Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday before noon or 6pm & later; Wednesday before 10am; Saturday, Sunday and Holidays after 1:00 PM
- Limited ability to fill in vacant spots in the afternoon where approved by the Pro Shop within 24 hours'
- Complimentary use of the clubhouse & practice facility
- Amenities including tees and pull carts
- Sponsored Junior Membership does not include a locker or club storage
- If you wish to not return to the Club the following season, you **MUST** advise the office via email by the deadline prescribed in our rules & regulations (March 1<sup>st</sup>). Failure to provide such notice by the deadline may result in dues being payable for following season
- The Sponsoring Member accepts responsibility for the general conduct and behavior of the Junior while he or she is at the Club
- Sponsored Junior Members agree to comply with the letters patent, by-laws, code of conduct, rules and regulations of Camelot Golf & Country Club
- High performance juniors have the opportunity to apply for bursaries from our Junior Development Fund to support their competitive golf efforts.

## Membership Fees:

- **\$650+HST** will be invoiced to the sponsored junior's account
- **Golf Canada Card:** \$39+HST billed in May
- There is no minimum F&B requirement, nor Capital Improvement or hole-in-one fees payable
